Update on COVID-19 in Montgomery County PA – April 24, 2020

Each week, the Montgomery County Commissioners have hosted a WebEx call with faith leaders and leaders of faith-based organizations in Montgomery County. What follows is a summary of information shared by the Board of Commissioners: Val Arkoosh, Joe Gale and Ken Lawrence.

Based on Governor Wolf's plan shared this week at https://www.pa.gov/guides/responding-to-covid19/#PhasedReopening the entire state of PA is currently at Phase Red. The move, by county, to Phase Yellow will occur based on data in these five categories:

- 1. The number of new, confirmed cases/100,000 people per day
- 2. The capacity at hospitals
- 3. Having enough PPE and ventilators at hospitals
- 4. Having enough testing available for essential workers
- 5. Contact tracing availability

Montgomery County is working in a concerted effort with 4 other local counties in SE PA, so any changes made will be effective. Other information shared:

- Testing is currently happening at Montgomery County Community College. The current rate of those testing positive is 14% which appears to be a plateau.
- Montgomery County currently is seeing 187 new, confirmed cases of COVID-19 per day. That number will need to drop to an average of 30/day over a 14 day-period in order to move from Phase Red to Phase Yellow.
- All hospitals in Montgomery County currently have beds and ventilators available.
- Long term care facilities are seeing high rates of COVID-19 with both staff and residents. An effort is being made to test ALL staff and residents at long term care facilities.
- A large number of people of all ages who test positive are asymptomatic, which is one reason masks and social distancing are so important for EVERYONE.
- It is most likely that Montgomery County will be in Phase Red through May and into early June.

During Phase Yellow:

- Residents will still continue with masks and 6-ft social distancing
- Gathering will be limited to no more than 25 people. This includes churches.
- Very likely Montgomery County will be in Phase Yellow through the summer.

Food Pantries – The need at our area food pantries is 4 times what they normally see. Please help with donations of food or a monetary donation if possible.
